## Illinois Office of Broadband Programs

The Connect Illinois Broadband Grant Program is a best-practice approach to combine federal, state, and local funds with provider match contribution - (1) to expand fully-scalable broadband access to homes, businesses, and community anchors most in need and (2) to ensure continued access well into the future.


## Collaborative Projects

- Public ${ }^{1}$ Wi-Fi hotspots: 1
- ACP enrollment rate ${ }^{2}$ : $13 \%$
- Low-cost devices distributed (FY 2022): 0
- READY lead: Eastern Illinois University
- \$1.5B+ through State, ARPA, and IIJA to promote consistency, ensure efficiency \& align Rebuild Illinois, Capital Projects Fund, and BEAD program funding
- 50+ communities engaged in local planning \& capacity building support (Connected Communities, Accelerate Illinois \& Broadband Breakthrough programs)
- Regional Engagement for Adoption + Digital Equity (READY) program for ongoing community \& stakeholder support through inclusive regional teams
- Connect Illinois Computer Equity Network launched in 2020 to source, refurbish, and distribute computers to households in need throughout Illinois

Broadband Adoption Statistics (ACS 20215 -year estimates)

- Smartphone dependent households: $12 \%$
- Cellular Data dependent households: 15\%
- Households without a computing device: 10\%
- Households without an internet subscription: 17\%

# Federal BEAD and Digital Equity funding aligns with Connect Illinois programs, adding impacł to existing work 

Two new grant programs for states provide a generational opportunity to close the digital divide in Illinois!

## The Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) Program

- Allocates $\boldsymbol{\$} \mathbf{4 2 . 4 5 B}$ focused on broadband infrastructure deployment to all states
- Illinois is expected to receive an estimated $\$ 1 B+$ on top of other funding sources
- States must prioritize funds for:

1. Unserved service projects
2. Underserved service projects
3. Connecting community anchor institutions
4. Installing Wi-Fi infrastructure within residential buildings
5. Data collection
6. Broadband adoption

- States must coordinate with local stakeholders in the planning process
- States must extend access to ALL unserved locations

- Provides \$2.75B for digital literacy, computer access, and internet adoption initiatives via formula-based and competitive grants to states
- Example use of funds:
- Develop, implement, and oversee comprehensive digital equity plans
- Make awards to other entities to help in developing digital equity plans
- Improve the online accessibility and inclusivity of public resources
- Implement digital equity plans and digital inclusion activities
- Provide digital literacy and skills education to covered populations
